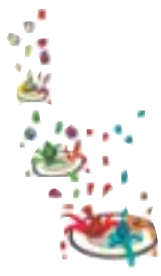

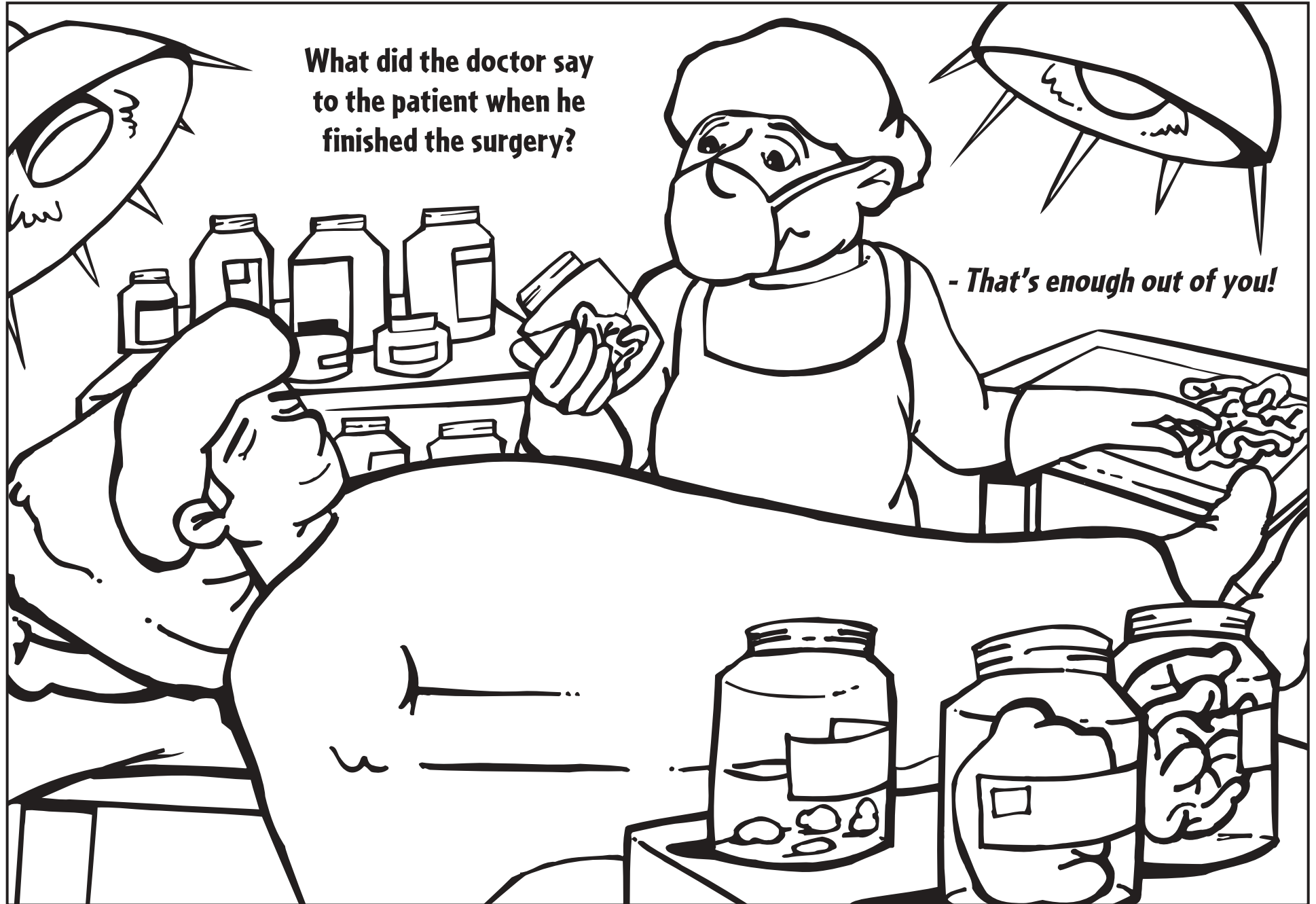

- 10.** Color your frog if you like. Press the back of it to make it jump! (A red arrow points to the back of the completed frog.)
